1. Action Items

a. Request from Sue Brayton to approve the Bond for the Junior/Senior High School and the Westport Elementary School.

Ms. Shufelt made a **MOTION** to approve the Vote of the Board of Selectmen as follows, which she read verbatim:

VOTE OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN

I, the Clerk of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Westport, Massachusetts (the "Town"), certify that at a meeting of the board held July 25, 2022, of which meeting all members of the board were duly notified and at which a quorum was present, the following votes were unanimously passed, all of which appear upon the official record of the board in my custody:

<u>Voted</u>: We hereby determine, in accordance with G.L. c.70B, that the cost of the Westport Middle/High School construction authorized by vote of the Town passed on January 23, 2018 (Article 1) and the Westport Elementary School roof replacement project authorized by vote of the Town passed on October 3, 2020 (Article 1) being financed with proceeds of a portion of the Bonds, together with all other bonds and notes of the Town previously issued to pay costs of this project, does not exceed the portion of the total cost of the project that is not being paid by the school facilities grant and we hereby approve the issuance of notes and bonds to finance these projects under G.L. c.70B.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that the sale of the \$8,740,000 General Obligation School Project Loan, Chapter 70B Bonds of the Town dated August 1, 2022 (the "Bonds"), to Fidelity Capital Markets, a division of National Financial Services, at the price of \$9,144,589.07 and accrued interest, if any, is hereby approved and confirmed. The Bonds shall be payable on August 1 of the years and in the principal amounts and bear interest at the respective rates, as follows:

Further Voted: to approve the sale of \$2,500,000 4.00 percent General Obligation School Bond Anticipation Notes of the Town dated August 3, 2022, and payable August 3, 2023 (the "Notes"), to Piper Sandler & Co. at par and accrued interest, if any, plus a premium of \$44,450.

Further Voted: that in connection with the marketing and sale of the Bonds, the preparation and distribution of a Notice of Sale and Preliminary Official Statement dated July 12, 2022, and a final Official Statement dated July 19, 2022 (the "Official Statement"), each in such form as may be approved by the Town Treasurer, be and hereby are ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that in connection with the marketing and sale of the Notes, the preparation and distribution of a Notice of Sale and Preliminary Official Statement dated July 12, 2022, and a final Official Statement dated July 19, 2022, each in such form as may be approved by the Town Treasurer, be and hereby are ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that the Bonds shall be subject to redemption, at the option of the Town, upon such terms and conditions as are set forth in the Official Statement.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that the Town Treasurer and the Board of Selectmen be, and hereby are, authorized to execute and deliver a Continuing and Significant Events Disclosure undertakings in compliance with SEC Rule 15c2-12 in such forms as may be approved by bond counsel to the Town, which undertakings shall be incorporated by

reference in the Bonds and Notes, as applicable, for the benefit of the holders of the Bonds and Notes from time to time.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that we authorize and direct the Town Treasurer to establish post issuance federal tax compliance procedures and continuing disclosure procedures in such forms as the Town Treasurer and bond counsel deem sufficient, or if such procedures are currently in place, to review and update said procedures, in order to monitor and maintain the tax-exempt status of the Bonds and Notes and to comply with relevant securities laws.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that any certificates or documents relating to the Bonds and the Notes (collectively, the "Documents"), may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be regarded as an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same

document; delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to a Document by electronic mail in a ".pdf" file or by other electronic transmission shall be as effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart signature page to such Document; and electronic signatures on any of the Documents shall be deemed original signatures for the purposes of the Documents and all matters relating thereto, having the same legal effect as original signatures.

Further Voted: that each member of the Board of Selectmen, the Town Clerk and the Town Treasurer be and hereby are, authorized to take any and all such actions, and execute and deliver such certificates, receipts or other documents as may be determined by them, or any of them, to be necessary or convenient to carry into effect the provisions of the foregoing votes.

Ms. Shufelt's motion was seconded by Mr. Brewer. The Board voted 3-0 in favor.
