Westport Finance Committee Meeting Minutes Remote Meeting April 02, 2024

Karen Raus called the meeting to order at 6:30pm, and a Pledge of Allegiance.

Karen Raus read the following: This meeting is being held remotely in accordance with the Governor of Massachusetts 'March 12, 2020, order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c.30A Section 20 and on March 29, 2023, Governor Healey signed a Supplemental 2023 Budget Bill allowing remote and hybrid meetings options for public bodies through March 31, 2025. This meeting is being recorded.

Karen Raus (Chair) opened the meeting by mentioning we will be reviewing and voting on the Warrant Articles and the Community Preservation Committee (CPC) Betty Slade was present to give a presentation of their warrant articles.

1.Review Warrant Articles:

Karen Raus opened the meeting to Betty Slade of the Community Preservation Committee on Articles 13.

There were questions and discussions by Finance Committee members in regard to the Article. Karen continued with a motion for Article 13 (See below Chart) for the motion and recommendation.

2.Recommendations for Annual Town Meeting:

The Town Administrator needs to finalize the Warrant, and the Select Board was looking to finalize the warrant on April 8, 2024, and were looking for any final edits.

Article 4 FY25 Budget

Karen mentioned for is our FY25 budget there's been no new information from the town administrator, nor further information from the state in regard to state aid.

From previous meetings, the following items were still to be discussed:

There were discussions regarding open items amongst the finance committee in regard to the town engineer, and animal control and school budget. The Finance Committee voted on each line item see below.

1) Town Engineer – new position.

The Finance Committee discussed this with Jim Hartnett at a previous meeting.

<u>Motion</u>: There was a motion made by Cindy Brown to leave the Town Engineer as requested in the budget recommended by the SelectBoard Hugh Morton seconded, the roll call vote was 8-1. Morton; aye, Carreiro nay; Thrasher; Brown; aye, Orlando; aye Lebreux; aye Law; aye, Raus; aye, Lees; aye

2) Animal Control – additional funds for a part-time assistance At a previous meeting, the finance Committee discussed the understaffing, The Board of Health submitted a proposal for an additional \$25,000.

<u>Motion:</u> Cindy Brown motioned that we include an additional \$25,000 in the Animal Control officer budget for a part time person. Zach Lebreux seconded ,the roll call vote was 9-0 Morton; aye Carreiro; aye ,Thrasher; aye, Lees; aye, Brown; aye Orlando; aye, Lebreux; aye Law; aye Raus; aye.

3) School Budget

The Finance Committee recognizes the needs of the School Department, but the fiscal situation limits the amount of funding available. The Finance Committee noted the FY24 budget included 500,000 of free cash and the draft 5-year operating plan called for a reduction of \$100,000 each year for 5 years. The Select Board budget included \$400,000 of free cash (which was the \$100,000 reduction from FY24) and an addition \$252,125 of additional revenue sharing in addition to the normal 54% sharing. These additional funds amounted to \$652,125 and exceeded the \$500,000 from FY24.

<u>Motion:</u> Hugh Morton motioned to keep the formula for the same the town 54% and 46% for the school Cindy Brown seconded the roll call vote was 9-0 Morton ;aye Carreiro ;aye Thrasher;aye Lees;aye,Brown ;aye, Orlando;aye Lebreux ;aye Law;aye Raus;aye

<u>Motion</u>: Hugh Morton made a motion to make \$500,000 for school budget from free cash. Al Lees seconded the roll call vote was 6-3. Morton;aye, Carreiro; nay Thrasher;nay Lees;aye Brown;aye, Orlando;nay Lebreux;aye,Law;aye,Raus;aye

<u>Motion:</u> Cindy Brown made the motion to approve Article 4 of the budget as amended subject to change reducing free cash \$152,125 and reducing school expense number \$152,125 Hugh Morton seconded the roll call vote was 7-2 Morton;ayeCarreiro;nay,Thrasher;nay, Lees ;aye, Brown;aye Orlando;aye Lebreux;aye Law;aye Raus;aye

The committee discussed the Free Cash numbers \$522,000 total broken down \$250,000 to Capitalization \$100,000 to Stabilization approximately \$172,000 Balance to free cash (carry over).

The Finance Committee discussed the remaining warrant articles and voted to make recommendations on the rest of the articles during the meeting.
