	<i>WHAT TO RECYCLE</i>		<i>WHAT NOT TO RECYCL</i>
	<i>MATERIAL</i>	<i>PREPARATION</i>	
<i>Paper</i>	Newspaper with inserts.	Bundle in paper bags or tie securely.	No books or magazines. No plastic strings or plastic bags.
<i>Junk Mail</i>	Any junk mail, magazines, white & color paper		No paper bags, plastic bags, cardboard, or string of any type.
<i>Cardboard</i>	Corrugated, including paperboard (cereal, pizza, paper towel roll, etc.)	Flatten boxes.	No waxed cardboard.
<i>Plastic</i>	All Plastics (including toys)	Plastics are separated into 4 categories. See separate handout for more details.	Plastic bags & cellophane or To Go containers/produce containers.
<i>Glass</i>	Empty, unbroken bottles & jars. Clear & colored glass.	Rinse. Remove all metal & plastic caps, lids, rings, & foils.	No plates, windows, or auto glass. No ceramics, dinnerware, Pyrex, mirrors, or light bulbs.
<i>5¢ Deposit bottles/cans</i>	5¢ Deposit bottles and cans	Rinse and remove caps.	Do not flatten. 5¢ deposit containers <u>only</u> . <i>This is a donation for the Boy Scouts.</i>
<i>Clothes</i>	Clean, usable clothing. Any type accepted	Bring clothing in a bag. Place in the designated containers.	No furniture, toys, appliances, books
<i>Cans</i>	Empty aluminum & tin food or beverage cans. Pie plates & aluminum foil.	Rinse. Flatten tin cans, if possible. Labels can be left on.	
<i>Scrap Metal</i>	Cast iron sinks, stoves, lawn mowers, metal bed springs, washers, dryers, hot water tanks, anything made of metal.	Remove doors. <b>No FREON items: refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or utilities with coolant.</b> <i>Suggest going to Excel Recycling or Mid-City Scrap.</i>	No capacitors in the white goods. If part of the original equipment, they must be brought intact and removed in presence of attendant. No automobile bodies. No metal parts tainted with oil or grease.
<i>Batteries</i>	All batteries		No leaks. Cannot be broken or cracked.
<i>Waste-Motor Oil</i>	Up to 2 Gallons/Household/Day	Name & address required. Must not be contaminated with any other compounds including water.	Antifreeze, contaminated oil, solvents.
<i>Mercury</i>	Fluorescent bulbs (not broken) & thermometers		Broken items

<i>Yard Waste</i>	Leaves, pine needles, weeds & grass clippings	May be left in biodegradable paper bags. No plastic bags.	No food waste. No commercial yard waste. No Stumps and No Brush

**CLOSED:** Tues., Wed. and Holidays. (No exceptions)

***STICKERS:*** \$35.00 - each vehicle (under age 65). 2<sup>nd</sup> sticker same day same household, \$10  
\$20 – each vehicle for age 65 and older. 2<sup>nd</sup> sticker same day same household, \$10  
Stickers are annual, July 1 thru June 30. If replacing the vehicle, peel sticker off and  
bring to the office for replacement at a fee of \$5. The fee is \$10 w/o the old sticker

***DAY PASSES:*** Day passes are available at the Board of Health Office. The fee is \$5. The pass is  
just for entry to the Transfer Station and good all day on that one day

***PUNCH CARDS:*** \$15.00 (card has 5 punches, each worth \$3)  
\$30.00 (card has 10 punches, each worth \$3)  
Punch cards to be used **ONLY** for bags of trash or a barrel of trash, up to 33 gallons

***TRASH:*** \$3.00 each bag up to 33-gallon size

***BULKY ITEMS:*** Bulky Items are assessed by the attendant starting at a minimum of \$5 and up based  
on the size and weight of item (ex: mattresses, chairs sofa, sofa w/bed, sectional, rug,  
table, bureau, etc.)

***METAL  
BULKY ITEMS:*** No Charge (ex.: washer, dryer, lawnmower, stove, hot water tank.) **NO** items with  
**FREON** (*refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifiers*)

***C & D*** Construction and Demolition Debris is now being accepted from **Residents only.**  
No gypsum board, no floor/ceiling tile, no shingles, no concrete, no asphalt and no  
brick. No Commercial Vehicles.

***TIRE  
DISPOSAL FEE:*** **A.** Passenger tires, unmounted - \$6.00; **B.** Passenger tires, mounted - \$6.00  
**C.** Lt. Truck Tires, unmounted - \$6.00; **D.** Lt. Truck Tires, mounted - \$7.00  
**E.** Lrg. Truck Tires, unmounted - \$10.00; **F.** Lrg. Truck Tires, mounted - \$20.00

***CRT  
DISPOSAL FEES:*** TVs (under 30 in.) - \$20.00; Monitors - \$20.00;  
TVs (30 in. & over) – Min. \$25.00; Console TVs – Min. \$25.00
