The available vaccines are as follows:

- ➤ <u>COVID Boosters</u> Bivalent (updated version of original vaccines)
 Formulations of the Moderna and of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines.
 - You must have completed a primary series of COVID-19 vaccinations to receive this new booster.
 - The Moderna Bivalent COVID-19 Vaccine is authorized as single booster dose for individuals 5 years of age and older.
 - The Pfizer Bivalent COVID-19 Vaccine is authorized as a single booster dose for individuals 5 years of age and older.
- ➤ <u>COVID Primary Series</u> Adult Vaccines of Moderna, Pfizer-BioNTech, Novavax and J&J and Pediatric Vaccines of Moderna, Pfizer-BioNTech only.
- > <u>Flu vaccine</u> Both High Dose (65 years and older) and children (3 years and older) and adult vaccines will be offered.

NOTE: You can choose to receive both the COVID Vaccines and FLU Vaccine at the same time. Primary COVID and BOOSTER <u>cannot</u> be done at the same time.

PLEASE BRING YOUR ID AND INSURANCE CARD TO THE CLINIC
FOR COVID VACCINE, PLEASE BRING COVID VACCINATION CARD

If you are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine booster, the updated booster you receive does not need to be from the same manufacturer you received for your primary vaccination or previous booster.
