TOWN OF WESTPORT, MASSACHUSETTS BOARD OF HEALTH
EMERGENCY ORDER UNDER DECLARATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY


ORDERED this 17th day of April 2020

Pursuant to the declaration of a public health emergency on March 20, 2020, 310 CMR 11.05, 105 CMR 300.200 and all other authorizing statutes and regulations, acting by and through its agent authorized under MGL c. 111, §31 we, the Board of Health of the Town of Westport, Massachusetts, hereby order the following:

- 1.) All members of the public entering any Essential Business as defined by Governor Baker's Covid-19 Executive Orders, including but not limited to grocery stores, pharmacies, home improvement stores and the like, must wear a cloth face covering, such as a fabric mask, scarf or bandana over his or her nose and mouth. The cloth face coverings recommended are not surgical masks or N-95 respirators, which should be left for medical professionals and first responders. - 2.) All members of the public entering a restaurant for the purpose of picking up food for take-out must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth.
- 3.) All employees of all Essential Businesses, as defined above, shall wear a face covering over their mouth and nose when interacting with the public and within six feet of a co-worker. Employers and employees must use prescribed protocols and guidelines for personal protective equipment such as gloves.
- 4.) Any resident or member of the general public entering or exiting a residential or commercial building complex of greater than one (1) unit must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth while in common areas and communal spaces and must exercise social distancing in these spaces in accordance with CDC guidelines. This emergency order shall be effective beginning MONDAY, APRIL 20, 2020 at 12:01AM and remain in effect until notice is given, pursuant to the Board of Health's judgement that the Public Health Emergency no longer exists.

This Order shall be enforced by Board of Health officials. Individuals who violate the provisions of this Emergency Order are subject to warnings/fines issued by the enforcing authority as follows: (1) first offense – a warning; (2) second offense – a fine of \$100; (3) third and further offenses – a fine of \$250.
