Westport Board of Health COVID-19 Update

April 24, 2020

Case Update: Total number of state confirmed COVID-19 positive cases in the Town of Westport as of April 22, 2020 is 16. The state is now reporting the number of COVID-19 cases and case rates by community every Wednesday afternoon and our town COVID-19 Case reporting page will provide a direct link each week. However, just in the last few days we have seen a spike of more than a dozen new cases that our Town Nurse is working diligently to confirm and conduct follow up contract tracing.

Sadly, the Health Department must report two additional deaths of long–time Westport residents, who had recently resided in nearby nursing homes. Also several residents have been hospitalized due to COVID-19 complications. Twelve persons have recovered to date.

Statewide there have been 46,023 cases and 2,360 deaths as of April 23rd. Massachusetts has been deemed a hot spot and we are in the surge at this time. Once the peak occurs, that means we are only halfway through the number of expected cases. Recent reporting also indicates that COVID-19 may flare up again in the summer or fall, so we need to remain vigilant for ourselves and our friends, neighbors and fellow residents.

The Health Department will update the public weekly or as needed with any new developments or changes in Town operations on the COVID-19 INFORMATION PAGE.

Other Westport COVID-related news:

- 1. Face Mask Order, effective 4/20/20: The BOH issued an EMERGENCY ORDER requiring the use of simple cloth face coverings to reduce risk of the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) when entering or working in public facilities such as grocery stores, pharmacies, convenience stores, etc. Employees of all Essential Businesses are also directed to wear a face covering when interacting with the public or within six feet of a co-worker. - 2. **The town's temporary Food Pantry** served over 120 families at its second pickup day on Monday. More donations are needed. Gift cards and cash are also accepted. Donation days are Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9 am to
