

The committee appointed by the Town at the annual Meeting held at the Town House on the first Monday of April last, to ascertain the situation and boundaries of the landing at the Head of the East river, and report at the adjournment of the same Meeting, what measures in their opinion would be necessary for the Town to adopt relative thereto - have attended the service assigned them, and now ask leave to report.

that we began on the West side of the river at a locust post by the East side of the wharf, in the line between the landing and the land of Humphrey Howland, formerly Dool's - from thence West five degrees North by the compass, eighteen rods to a stone set in the ground, at the North West corner of a dwelling House - which appears to be an ancient monument, from thence North five degrees West about 48 rods to the line of the Country Road, and near the North East corner of Isaac Howland's dwelling House - and is bounded Northwesterly on the Country Road - and Easterly on the River.

We then began on the East side of the river, at the North West corner of Thomas Winslow's dwelling House, which is about ten feet South Easterly from a rock marked A thence South twenty five degrees West, eighty feet, thence East ten & one half degrees South forty feet, thence South twenty five degrees West fifteen rods, one and one half feet to a stake, thence West eighteen and one half degrees South, two rods and nine feet to a stake, thence South two & one half degrees East twelve rods to a heap of Stones, thence West eighteen and one half degrees South, about two rods to the river - and is bounded Northwesterly on the Country Road and Easterly on the River.

as your committee are not aware of the necessity, at this time of the Town adopting any further measures relative thereto other than to order this report inserted on the Records of the Town, ask leave to be discharged from the further consideration of the subjects - all which is respectfully submitted
