The following is the bill of the Highway Taxes of the persons against whose names they are set, and which you are directed to have expended in work and materials upon the Highways, Townways, and Bridges, within the limits assigned to you by the Selectmen.

You are to give reasonable notice to each person herein named, of the sum he is assessed to Highways and Townways, and also seven days' notice of the times and places you may appoint, providing materials and working on said Highways and Townways in your District.

And you are to cause two-thirds, at least, of said sums to be expended before the First day of July next. You are to exhibit this Tax bill to the Selectmen on the first Monday of July, and also at the expiration of your term of office, and at those times respectively to render an account of all moneys by you expended.

Pursuant to a vote of the Town, you are required to return a true list to the Assessors, on the First day of September, of all persons that have neglected to work out their Highway Taxes, and their deficiencies set against their names.

You will allow for work at the following rates:
