POWER OF ATTORNEY.

From *Theodore Tipton & Emma Bledgett*

To *Bradford Coggeshall*

Date, *July* 189 *1*

Know all Men by these Presents,

That We Theodore A. Tripp of New Haven, Conn. and Emma J. Blodgett of Springfield Mass, have constituted, ordained and made, and in our stead and place put and by these presents do constitute, ordain and make, and in our stead and place put Bradford Coggeshall of Westport, County of Bristol, and Commonwealth of Mass,

to be our true, sufficient and lawful Attorney for us and in our name and stead, and to transact, determine, accomplish, act upon and decide and finish all matters or questions that may arise, from the date of this instrument until revoked by us or some legal representative for us, in any and all meetings of whatsoever nature or description that may be held in any place concerning or connected with Linden Grove Cemetery Association, or in any way connected with the afore-said premises. The afore-said Tripp and Blodgett owning the East half of Lot No. 5 in the afore-said Cemetery. The said Linden Grove Cemetery is situated in the Town of Westport, County of Bristol, and Commonwealth of Mass, the afore-said Bradford Coggeshall being the owner of the West half of the afore-said Lot No. 5.

GIVING AND HEREBY GRANTING unto our said Attorney full and whole strength, power and authority in and about the premises; and to take and use all due means, course and process in the law, for the obtaining and recovering the same; and of recoveries and receipts thereof, and in our name to make, seal and execute due acquittance and discharge; and for the premises to appear, and the person of us the constituents to represent before any governor, judges, justices, officers and ministers of the law whatsoever, in any court or courts of judicature, and there, on our behalf, to answer, defend and reply unto all actions, causes, matters and things whatsoever, relating to the premises. Also, to submit any matter in dispute, to arbitration or otherwise; with full power to make and substitute one or more attorneys under our said Attorney and the same again at pleasure to revoke. And generally to say, do, act, transact, determine, accomplish and finish all matters and things whatsoever relating to the premises, as fully, amply and effectually, to all intents and purposes, as we the said constituents if present, ought or might personally, although the matter should require more special authority than is herein comprised, we the said constituents ratifying, allowing and holding firm and valid, all and whatsoever our said Attorney or his substitutes shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, in and about the premises, by virtue of these presents.




