To the Assessors of the Town of Westforf

In obedience to a law of the Commonwealth aforesaid, passed the twenty-sixth day of May, nineteen hundred five, entitled, "An Act to apportion and assess a State Tax of Four Millions Dollars," you are, in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, required forthwith to assess the sum of Dollars, being the sum by said act assessed upon said Town, the same to be assessed according to the provisions of the twelfth chapter of the Revised Laws, and to add the amount of such tax to the amount of Town and County taxes to be assessed by you on said Town.

You are likewise required to pay, or issue your warrant requiring the Treasurer of said Town to pay, to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth, ON OR BEFORE THE TENTH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1905, the aforesaid sum of \$2/60.

And you are further required to return a certificate of the NAME OF THE TREAS-URER of your Town, with his Post-office address and the sum which he is required to collect, to the said Treasurer of the Commonwealth, at some time before the first day of October next. And you are also to observe and perform all other matters and things required of you by the aforesaid law passed May twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred five.
