you are hereby authorized and ordered to pay all notes that may fall due during your term of office, and all interest that may fall due on outstanding notes against the town during said term.

And you are ordered to pay over to Elmer A. Stevens Esq Treasurer of said Commonwealth the sum of Four thousand six hundred and forty dollars (\$4,640.00) this town proportion of a state tax of Eight Million Dollars, together with the sum of Two hundred twelve and $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars (\$212.50) this town's proportion of a State highway tax, on or before the fifteenth day of November 1913.

And you are to pay over to ^{the} Treasurer of Bristol County the sum of Two thousand nine hundred fifty three and $\frac{12}{100}$ dollars (\$2,953.12) the same being this town's proportion for the County Tax, on or before the twentieth day of October 1913

you are also authorized and ordered to pay all amounts that will be due on outstanding orders for State Aid and Soldier's relief or that may be issued during your term of office.

you are to pay for State Aid and Soldier's relief as follows
