VOTED: That for the purpose of meeting the appropriations made under Articles 22 and 23 and \$8,500 of the appropriation made under Article 18 and \$3500 made under Article 11, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Selectmen, be and hereby is authorized to borrow a sum not exceeding \$37,000.00 and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor, said bonds or notes to be issued under authority granted by Sec. 7, Chap. 44, General Laws. Bonds or notes issued under authority of this vote shall be payable in accordance with Sec. 19 of said Chap. 44 so that the whole loan shall be paid in not more than five years from the date of issue of the first bond or note or at such earlier dates as the Treasurer and Selectmen may determine. That \$1,000 be transferred from Revenue. That the balance of the appropriations not otherwise provided for be raised by taxation.
