Question

Shall the town of Westport be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to engineer, design, and construct water and sewerage systems in the greater Route 6 area?

Yes _____ No _____

A yes vote would exempt the payment from the provisions of proposition two and one-half and allow the Town to borrow for the Route 6 Sewer and Water Project.

Explanation: The Town of Westport has proposed installing a sewer main for the entire length of Route 6, this would be tied into the Fall River treatment facility. The project also includes extending the water main from its current terminus in Route 6 near 666 State Road (Housing Authority Property) easterly within the limits of Route 6 to the Dartmouth Line. A positive vote on this question is needed before voters at Town Meeting can authorize the borrowing for the project.

Note: Wording of the question is very specific and must follow state guidelines. The amount of the exemption or the amount of borrowing cannot be included in the ballot question. Voters will have the opportunity to vote on the amount at the Annual Town Meeting to be held on May 7, 2024.
