Item # 1 – Westport – Green Communities

The Town has been designated as a Green Community. With the designation is a grant for \$158,710. I am working on the project application describing how these funds can be spent. It has to be submitted by the end of February.

Item #2 – Financial Management Structure Review

Attached is the Financial Management Structure Review report prepared by UMASS Boston with the help of a Community Compact Grant. I have invited the author in for a presentation to the Board. No confirmation yet.

Item #3 - Westport High/Middle School Reuse

Utile, the firm hired to assist the Town with a plan for the reuse of the Westport High/Middle School has completed the Preliminary Schemes portion of the study. A copy is attached. The next step is for the Town to seek input from the public, neighbors, and other town officials. In the meantime Utile will develop more information on alternative housing scenarios including affordable housing.
