Item #1 – Westport Campground – Environmental Assessment

Campbell Environmental Inc. has completed the environmental assessment of the Westport Campground including the two buildings. No evironmental contamination was found on the grounds. There is some modest asbestos in the buildings. George Campbell estimated it as 100 square feet of tile in the showers, 450 square feet of tile in the studio and 370 square feet in the front office. The other ACM quantities look small as shown on the attached list. The full 160 page report is available on-line at the Town Website, I can forward you an e-copy and one hard copy is in the BOS Office.

Item #2 - Westport LED Streetlight Project

Attached is an inventory of all the installed LED streetlights and their locations.

Item #3 - Diman Regional Vocational School – Feasibility Study

Diman Regional School has been invited into the MSBA Feasibility Process for a major school project. See attached letter.

Item #4 – High/Middle School Reuse

The Board Chair, Don Davidson, Chair of the Long-Term Building Committee and I are meeting with Senator Rodrigues soon. A Monday meeting had to be rescheduled.

Item # 5 – Landfill Solar Project

Attached is a July 10, 2019 drone photo of Ameresco's new solar array site on top of the Westport closed landfill. Completion is expected in August.

Item #6 - Former UST Site behind Town Hall - Environemental Testing

Since the discovery of a leaking UST behind Town Hall in 1998 the Town has had to have annual testing of the site. The Town had installed numerous test wells for this purpose. Attached is the report that resulted from the most recent tests. Overall every thing looks good. (See page 5-7 of the attached report). Annual testing will still be required.

One of the requirements of the Green Communities Application is to have energy audits completed on all the buildings. With the assistance of Power Management we have been able to retain the services, at no charge, from Energysource. They will complete all the audits.
