LEGAL NOTICE

TOWN OF WESTPORT, MA PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Town of Westport By-laws and Regulations Section XLV, Water Ways Regulations (not a by-law), a public hearing will be held by the Westport Board of Selectmen, on Monday December 2, 2019 at 6:05 p.m. at the Westport Town Hall, 816 Main Road, 2nd floor meeting room, Westport, MA for proposed amendments to Section 4506 WATERWAYS RULES AND REGULATIONS, paragraphs "C. Water Skiing"; "D. Personal Watercraft and Water Skiing" and to include N. "Winter Mooring in Area B" in same section as follows:

- C. Water Skiing As herein before permitted is subject to the provisions of the Chapter 90 B General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and to the further restriction that there shall be no water skiing, within four hundred (400) feet of bathers, divers, piers, wharves, floats, moored boats or any shore, or within a marked channel. "Water-skiing" shall include towing or manipulation of a wake board, knee board, tube, surfboard or other similar devices behind a motorboat. No water skiing activity shall occur between the hours of sunset and sunrise.
- D. Personal Watercraft As herein before permitted is subject to the provisions of the Chapter 90 B General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and to the further restriction that there shall be no personal watercraft operation within four hundred (400) feet of bathers, divers, piers, wharves, floats, moored boats or any shore unless at "headway speed". Personal Watercraft shall include all jet skis, motor propelled surfboards or water bikes. No personal watercraft operation shall occur between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

N. Winter Mooring in Area B – No Boat shall remain on its mooring in area B between the dates of December 21st and March 21st.

Item #1 – Senior Center Holiday Open House

Item #2 - Principal Assessor Recruitment

The deadline for Principal Assessor applications has ended. The BOA and I will be meeting with several candidates over the next two weeks. Finalists might be presented at the BOS meeting on December 16.

Item #3 - FY 21 Capital Improvement Planning

The CIPC is in the process of prioritizing the numerous projects submitted by the various departments.

Item #4 – Green Communities- Westport Application

Eric Abrene from SRPEDD has submitted the town's Green Communities application.

Item #5 – Treasurer Recruitment

The application period for the Treasurer recruitment ends on Monday, December 2. My group is starting to review applications, prepare a candidate scoring sheet, and interview questions.

Item #6 – Old Police Station Demolition

Work by the contractor Encore Contracting Associates began on Monday, November 18.

Item #7 – Cybersecurity Awareness Program
