Other suggestions?
- **Permits update.** Where do we stand with (1) the Massachusetts Highway Department for digging up Route 6, (2) the Water Resources Commission and its Inter-Basin Transfer Act, and (3) the Westport Conservation Commission with a Notice of Intent?
