## TOWN OF WESTPORT REQUIREMENTS FOR A NEW HOUSE APPLICATION/PERMIT

- Completed application permit obtained from the Westport Building Inspectors office
  - Must be completed in full/detail (do not put "see plans"), including a Total Project cost indicated on Page 3 and signed on Page 3
- Two sets of Plans one set must be no larger than 11 & 17
  - If there are roof trusses on the new house, the plans must be stamped by an engineer
- <u>2015</u> Mass Res Checklist (Energy Report) can be obtained from the insulation contractor or the company you purchased the insulation from. Be sure to provide ALL pages, not just the Summary Pages.
- Site Plan including Septic Layout & indicating if in a Flood Zone
- Construction Supervisor's License & Home Improvement Registration
- Liability Insurance Certificate
- · Workman's Compensation Certificate

If the home is Modular, the permit must be applied for by someone with a valid Construction Supervisor's License

Upon receipt of all the above items by the Building Inspector's office, a <u>Foundation Only</u> permit will be issued once reviewed. Once the Foundation is in, the Building Inspector will do a final inspection and sign off on the Foundation Permit. Once this has been done, this office needs to receive a stamped As Built showing the Proposed and Actual Elevation. Only then, will the applicant be able to obtain the actual Building Permit.
