The Westport Cultural Council is pleased to announce \$23,000 in grants awarded to 18 non-profit organizations and artists through the Helen E. Ellis Trust. The Council reviewed all applicants and selected those that promise to engage the citizens of Westport with creative, innovative programs and benefit a wide variety of neighborhoods and ages.

Westport resident Helen E. Ellis (1889-1987) had a lifelong dedication to the arts and culture. Miss Ellis cultivated community-wide interests and encouraged others to develop their creative talents. She was elected to the National Association of Women Artists and Sculptors. The Helen E. Ellis Trust was established to carry on her mission and honor her memory.

Each year the Westport Cultural Council solicits ideas and applications for programs that will enrich our community. This year we are excited to support musical concerts, school programs, artists in residence, and open studio tours. Nature and science programs offer a special highlight of the summer season.
