	<i>MATERIAL</i>	<i>PREPARATION</i>	
Paper	Newspaper with inserts.	Bundle in paper bags or tie securely.	No books or magazines. No plastic strings or plastic bags.
Junk Mail	Any junk mail, magazines, white & color paper		No paper bags, plastic bags, cardboard, or string of any type.
Cardboard	Corrugated, including paperboard (cereal, pizza, paper towel roll, etc.)	Flatten boxes.	No waxed cardboard.
Plastic	All Plastics (including toys)	Plastics are separated into 2. Regular plastics and rigid plastic	No plastic bags or cellophane
Glass	Empty, unbroken bottles & jars. Clear & colored glass.	Rinse. Remove all metal & plastic caps, lids, rings, & foils.	No plates, windows, or auto glass. No ceramics, dinnerware, Pyrex, mirrors, or light bulbs.
5¢ Deposit bottles/cans	5¢ Deposit bottles and cans	Rinse and remove caps.	Do not flatten. 5¢ deposit containers <u>only</u> . <i>This is a donation for the Boy Scouts.</i>
Textiles Recovery	Clean, usable clothing, linens, blankets etc. Any type accepted. Torn or stained ok as long as it is clean. No oils or chemicals	Bring clothing in a bag. Place in the designated containers.	No furniture, toys, appliances, books
Cans	Empty aluminum & tin food or beverage cans. Pie plates & aluminum foil.	Rinse. Flatten tin cans, if possible. Labels can be left on.	
Scrap Metal	Cast iron sinks, stoves, lawn mowers, metal bed-springs, washers, dryers, hot water tanks, anything made of metal.	<u>No FREON</u> items-refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or utilities with coolant. Suggest going to Excel Recycling or Mid-City Scrap.	No capacitors in the white goods. If part of the original equipment, they must be brought intact and removed in presence of attendant. No automobile bodies. No metal parts tainted with oil or grease.
Batteries	All batteries		No leaks. Cannot be broken or cracked.
Waste-Motor Oil	Up to 2 gallons per household per day	Name & address required. Must not be contaminated with any other compounds including water.	Antifreeze, contaminated oil, solvents.
Mercury	Fluorescent bulbs (not broken) & thermometers		Broken items

Yard Waste	Leaves, pine needles, weeds & grass clippings	May be left in biodegradable paper bags. No plastic bags.	No food waste. No commercial yard waste. No Stumps and No Brush

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW): A HHW Day is only planned when money can be appropriated to cover the cost. However, there is a facility in Sutton, MA to bring your HHW. Please visit their website at www.NEDT.org or call 866-769-1621 for more information.

The Following Items Are Not Accepted: HHW (including paint), Brush, Stumps, Car Parts, Shingles, Gypsum Board, Floor/Ceiling Tiles, Asphalt, Brick, Concrete, All Paint Cans and Small Pressurized Containers.

STICKERS: \$50 – under age 65, 2nd sticker same day same household, \$10
\$40 – age 65 and older, 2nd sticker same day same household, \$10
Stickers are annual, July 1 thru June 30. If replacing the vehicle, peel sticker off, bring to office to replace, fee is \$5. The fee is \$10 without the old sticker.

DAY PASSES: Day passes are available at the Board of Health Office. The fee is \$15. The pass is just for entry to the Transfer Station and good all day on that one. day

PUNCH CARDS: \$25.00 (card has 5 punches, each worth \$5); \$45.00 (card has 10 punches, each worth \$5). Punch cards are used ONLY for bags of trash or a barrel of trash.

TRASH: \$5.00 each bag/barrel up to 33-gallons, anything larger will be considered \$10.

BULKY ITEMS: For Bulky items, see separate fee schedule (bulky examples: chairs, sofa, sofa with bed, sectional, rug, table, bureau, etc. See below for mattress & box spring prices). Plastic bulky is recyclable, see separate sheet for plastic recycling details.

***MATTRESSES/
BOX SPRINGS*** Mattresses and box springs not qualifying for recycling are \$75 each. If it qualifies for recycling, they are \$20 each.

***METAL
BULKY ITEMS:*** No Charge. Examples: washer, dryer, lawnmower (*fluids must be drained*), stove, hot water tank. **NO** items with **FREON** (ex. *refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifier*).

C & D Residential Construction and Demolition Debris is accepted from **Residents only**. No sheet rock/gypsum board, no floor or ceiling tiles, no shingles, no concrete, no asphalt and no bricks. No Commercial businesses.

TIRE • Passenger Tires - \$10.00 • Large Truck Tires - \$15.00
DISPOSAL FEE: • Light Truck Tires - \$12.00 • Tractor Tires - \$20.00

CRT (tv/monitors) • TV/Monitor under 30in: \$25
DISPOSAL FEES: • TV/Monitor 30in and up or console: \$45

***ITEMS NOT
ACCEPTED:*** Hazardous waste, paint cans-regardless if empty or hardened paint, car parts, dirt, brush, small-pressurized containers, stumps, sheet rock/gypsum board, floor or ceiling tiles, shingles, concrete, asphalt, bricks.
