Dear Westport Water Customer,

The Town of Westport is a registered Public Water Supply with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, Drinking Water Program. The Public Water Supply Identification Number (PWSID #) is 4334090. The Town's water distribution system begins at the Fall River / Westport boundary and travels in an Easterly direction along Route 6 to the Davis Road area.

If you receive your drinking water from the Town's distribution system then you are receiving 100% of your water from the Fall River Water Department. The Town of Westport is required to sample its distribution system for Trihalomethanes and Haloacetic Acids which are byproducts that are produced when organic matter combines with chlorine. The town is also required to sample for Lead and Copper at the customer's home. Below are the most recent sample results.

The Town of Westport has worked diligently to flush the distribution system and installed blow-off valves to reduce the water residence time, the sampling frequency has been reduced to quarterly sampling.
