The property is also known as Assessor's Map-61, Lot 19-A.

<u>Lawrence Webb & Janet Hadley, 82 Shirley Street</u> RE: Application request for a variance for relief from Zoning Bylaws, Article 7, Section 6 to allow the construction of a garage not meeting yard or setback requirements. The property is also known as Assessor's Map-71, Lot 81.

*Present was Attorney Brian Corey, representing petitioner.
